The Children's Center

\$1.00/day helps provide a hot lunch and nutritious snack for a child who is on the Sliding Fee Program at The Children's Center.

Semcac

\$44/day provides a homeless family with their own apartment including kitchen, bath, and bedrooms. Each household receives case management to reach the goal of permanent housing and achieve self-sufficiency.

Family Y

\$2/week provides a youth with a Y membership

Cedar Valley Services-

\$30.00/week provides on the job training and support for a client who works for Cedar Valley Services.

The Arc of Freeborn County

\$10.00/month provides four scholarships for children with developmental disabilities to attend The Arc's summer programs and enjoy activities in the community along with their peers.

Senior Resources

\$50/month provides 42 senior clients with help from the senior advocate such as receiving nutritional food deliveries (NAPS), finding the right Medicare Part-D program, and help finding other financial resources that the senior may qualified for.

Parenting Resource Center

\$25.00 provides 24 hours of safe, licensed emergency care for a disadvantaged child

Girl Scouts

\$115 provides a 4 Day Troop Camp: Kids explore camp and the outdoors with a variety of camp activities like swimming, boating, campfires, and more.
