UWFC Note: We are keeping information simple to protect privacy. This is a family that experienced
domestic violence, and while they're out of the "crisis" mode for now, the provider noted that mom
has been so focused on work, taking care of her children and the criminal process that there isn't much
room for anything else. Provider stated, "I want her to have the joy and to celebrate Christmas
with her babies.". We recognize this might be difficultso we are happy to help brainstorm. Ideas might
include a family membership to the Y so she can take the babies/toddlers there and enjoy the toddler
gym, or utilize Child Watch while she works out, etc. Clothing, consumable household goods, consider
baby wipes and diapers (we will ask about brand/sizes) or toddler snacks. It may help to consider
toddler/preschool items as a whole rather than for each individual childthink like a children's
tent for those super cold winter days or puzzles and books that all three of them would
benefit from!
