Pop Up Pantries

From May 2020-May 2021, UWFC partnered with Channel One Regional Food Bank to host monthly Pop-Up Pantries. 155,602 pounds of fresh produce, meat/protein and dairy were given to families at no cost

Safety Net Fund

Allocated over \$64,000 as part of a COVID-19 Relief Fund Program
